


BUTTON STORY



Child Abuse Prevention Training Programs

THE MISSION OF DAVIS HOUSE CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER IS TO COMBAT CHILD ABUSE BY COORDINATING SERVICES TO CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES IN CRISIS, AND PROVIDING COMMUNITY EDUCATION THROUGH PREVENTION AND EARLY INTERVENTION. WE OFFER A VARIETY OF TRAINING OPTIONS, INCLUDING:

	<p>Darkness to Light's Stewards of Children is a comprehensive sexual abuse prevention training program that educates adults to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. It is a 2-3 hour training that is facilitator-led, incorporating videos, workbooks, and discussion segments. (This training is NASW, CEU, POST, and TrainTN approved.)</p>
	<p>The 411 on Child Abuse is a child sexual abuse and physical abuse prevention training. It is a 45 minute to 1.5 hour training that is facilitator-led and includes a PowerPoint presentation.</p>
	<p>Darkness to Light's Prevent Now! is a general awareness training with statistical information on child abuse. It is a 20-45 minute training that is facilitator-led and includes a PowerPoint presentation and discussion segments.</p>
	<p>Monique Burr Foundation's Child Safety Matters and Teen Safety Matters is a comprehensive, evidence-based prevention program that covers abuse, bullying, and internet safety. It consists of two 45 minute lessons (or four shorter lessons) that is facilitator-led, and includes a PowerPoint presentation and discussion segments. (This program satisfies "Erin's Law" legislative requirements.)</p>
	<p>"The Nurturing Parenting Programs are a family-centered trauma-informed initiative designed to build nurturing parenting skills as an alternative to abusive and neglecting parenting and child-rearing practices." This program includes twelve parenting lessons to help reduce rates of recidivism of abuse, as well as teaching positive parenting behaviors. The twelve-lesson program can be broken into either 12-, 6-, or 4- sessions to best serve your group.</p>
	<p>We offer customized trainings based on specific organizational needs. Reach out to see what Davis House can offer you!</p>
